# **Key Elements of Proposed Voter Legislation**

### Absentee ballots:

- Reduces days to apply for absentee ballots from 160 to 78 days before an election and last day to apply 11 days (not 4) before election
- 2. Must provide birthday & driver's license # (or copies of other acceptable information) to <u>request</u> absentee ballot
- 3. To <u>submit</u> an absentee ballot, must provide last 4 digits of Social Security # or driver's license # on back of outer envelope
- Extends time hospitalized person can request ballot from 5 10 days

#### Drop boxes:

- Limited to 1 box for every early voting location or 1/100,000 registered voters, which ever is less.
- Drop boxes must be <u>inside</u> early voting locations, accessible <u>only</u> during hours of early voting, and under <u>constant</u> surveillance

#### Early voting:

- 9 AM 5 PM Mon. Fri., but <u>may</u> extend hours from 7 AM 7 PM
- Mandatory 2nd and 3rd Saturday voting from 9 AM 5 PM and 2nd or 3rd (or both) Sundays <u>optional</u>

#### <u>Provisional ballots:</u>

 Voters can only cast a provisional ballot <u>after 5 PM on Election Day</u> and must <u>sign sworn statement</u> with reason unable to vote a correct polling location
